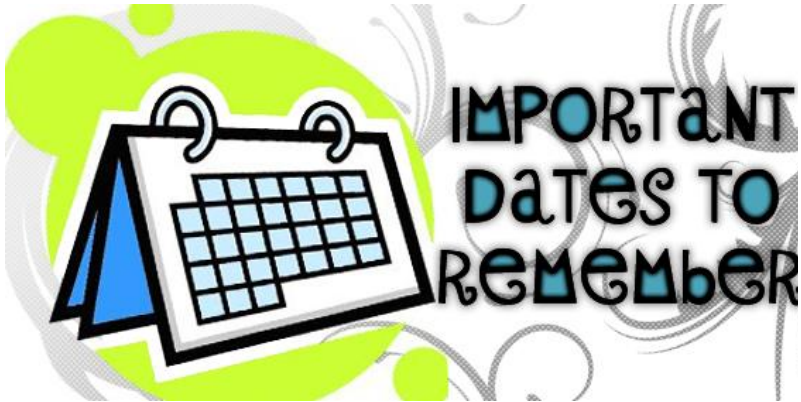

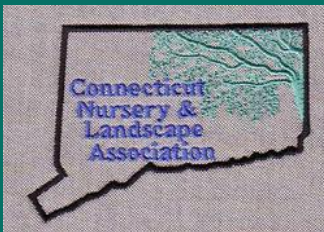

## Attention Members in the New Haven/Fairfield area

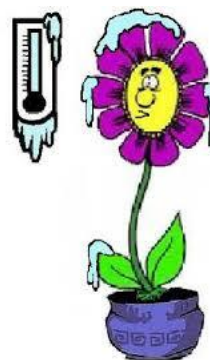


Members of the New Haven/Fairfield areas should have received an email from CNLA with a survey from Dr. Campbell in regards to hourly wages of several types of workers.

An article issued in *Greenhouse Management* shares the request of The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) for public comment on a proposal to remove 72 chemicals from the approved list of substances used as inert ingredients in pesticide products.

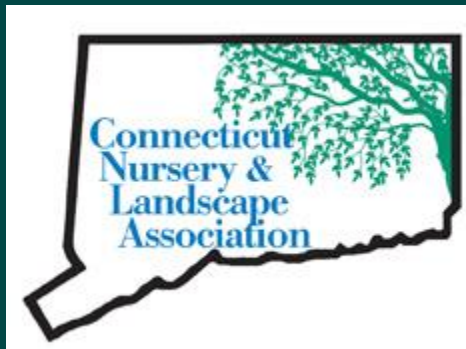
