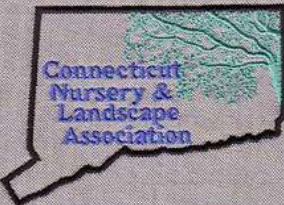

The Connecticut Accredited Nursery Professional Program is a voluntary program to accomplish the following: To encourage on-going professional improvement through education and service to the industry and retain certification status, all CANPs must compile at least five credits yearly to keep their status current and pay an annual fee (starting with the 2010 class and going forward) of \$10 for CNLA members and \$20 for nonmembers.
