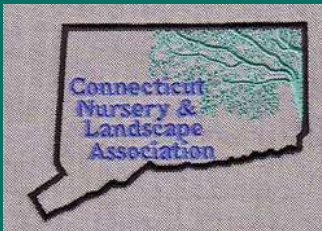

Garden Clubs and nurseries in Connecticut are invited to submit design proposals for gardens to be added to the Connecticut Trees of Honor Memorial that is currently under construction in Veterans Memorial Park, Middletown. Gardens may be planted this fall or spring 2016 and may include perennial or annual flowers, shrubbery and

hardscape in various areas in the two and one-half acre Memorial site. Awarded designs must be planted and maintained by respective clubs, nurseries or landscape companies.

This unique, living trees, state-wide Memorial pays special tribute to Connecticut's 65 military members who gave the ultimate sacrifice while deployed to the wars in Iraq and Afghanistan. The Memorial will also pay tribute to all CT veterans and military members. Phase Two of construction is currently underway.

Design submissions are due by September 30, 2015. All submission decisions will be made by the CTHM Executive Committee and the awarded clubs and nurseries will be notified on or before October 15, 2015.
