Dustyn Nelson, CANP



Bees and Butterflies Could Soon Be on Legislative Agenda:

Hartford, Conn. (AP) -- Connecticut could soon join the ranks of states seeking to boost the health of bees and butterflies. The effort comes as federal officials work on a national strategy to restore honeybee colony health to sustainable levels by 2025, increase Eastern monarch butterfly populations by 2020 and eventually restore millions of acres of land for pollinators. State Sen. Ted Kennedy Jr. sees the issue as an economic one in Connecticut, where several bumblebee species have declined. He is in the early stages of coming up with possible legislation for the new session, which began Feb. 3.



UConn Extension Launches First State-Wide Agricultural Water Use Survey:

UConn Extension is helping agricultural producers enhance water security and prepare for drought with the February launch of the first statewide agricultural water survey. The survey, the first effort to document water use in Connecticut agriculture, will be used to establish baseline standards for water use for all types of agricultural operations in each of the state's eight counties.

Participation in the survey is voluntary and anonymous, and takes about 10 minutes to complete. The project team also seeks agricultural operations to act as pilot sites for the installation of water meters to supplement existing data on water use.
