Program Overview

CNLA's annual **13-week certification program** will teach you the basics of botany, plant identification, and professional horticultural information. The low admission fee for the Connecticut Accredited Nursery Professional program makes accreditation open to all persons in the nursery and landscape industry and is honored in all six New England states. Learn directly from several instructors, who give great, two-hour informative lectures each night. Pass the CANP exam and you will be recognized in a graduation ceremony at the CNLA Winter Symposium in January.

Most classes are held on Tuesday evenings from **7:00 pm-9:00 pm beginning August 14** at **Jones Auditorium**. Register early as enrollment is limited.
