Program Overview

CNLA's annual **13-week certification program** will teach you botany, plant identification, and professional horticultural information. The low admission fee for the Connecticut Accredited Nursery Professional program makes accreditation open to all persons in the nursery and landscape industry and is honored in all six New England states. Learn directly from several instructors, who give great, two-hour informative lectures each night. Pass the CANP exam and you will be recognized at the CNLA Winter Symposium in January.

The on-line classes will be held on Tuesday evenings from **7:00—9:00 pm beginning August 11**. Prior to the start of class, a link to login to the on-line course will be emailed to you. Only registered attendees can participate in the class.
